A couple of guys have indicated some interest but no firm "takes" yet.

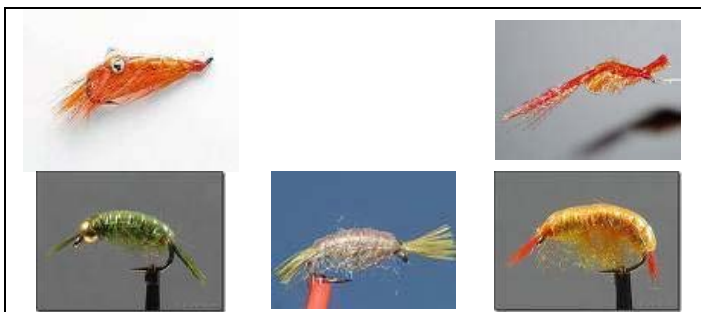
The duties could easily be split up between two or more guys who I would "guide" along the process.
